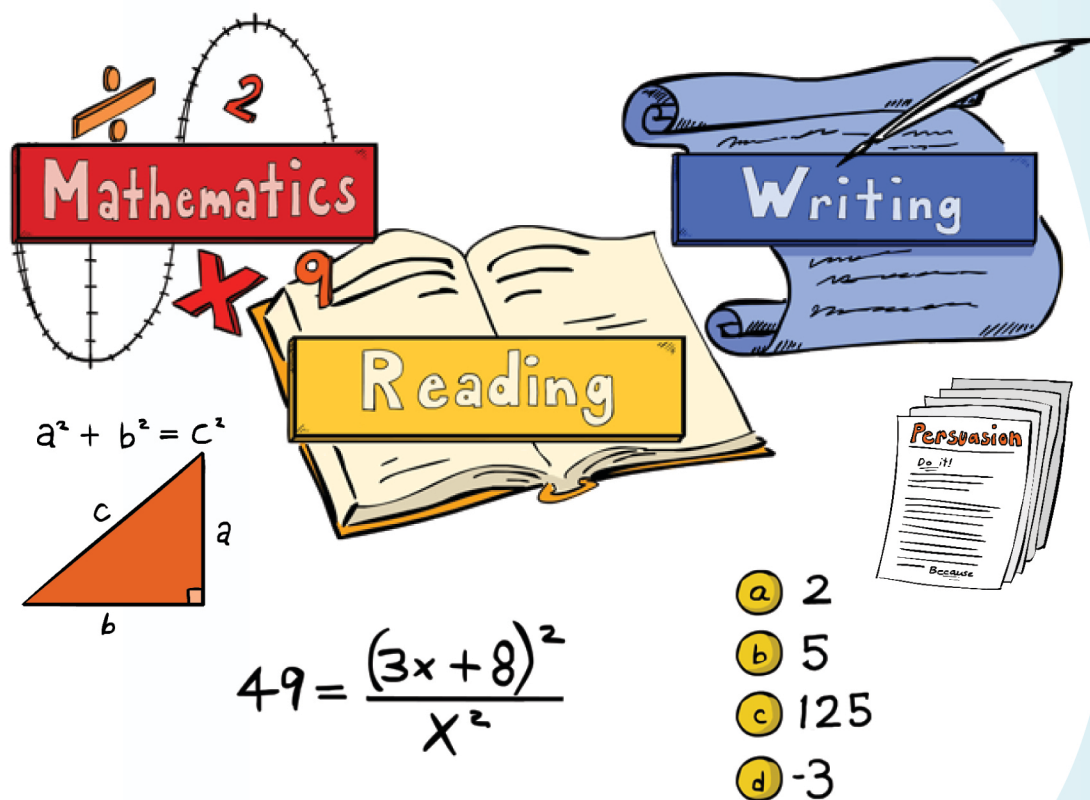
WHAT IS THE TSI ASSESSMENT?

A placement test used by your advisor to help place you in the right level courses.

WHY STUDY FOR IT?

Studying will save you time and money!

- Doing your best means a higher score.
- A higher score means fewer developmental education courses.
- Fewer dev ed courses means using your precious time and tuition dollars for courses that count towards your degree.



WHAT'S ON IT?

Mathematics

Elementary Algebra, Intermediate Algebra, Functions, Geometry, Measurement, Data Analysis, Statistics, and Probability

Reading

Literary Analysis, Main Idea and Supporting Details, Inference, and Author's Use of Language

Writing

Essay Revision, Agreement, Sentence Structure, and Sentence Logic. Many students will also be asked to write a persuasive essay.

WHAT IS IT LIKE?

Multiple choice PLUS the possible essay.

Adaptive - Questions get easier or harder depending on how you respond.

Untimed - Can take up to 5 hours.

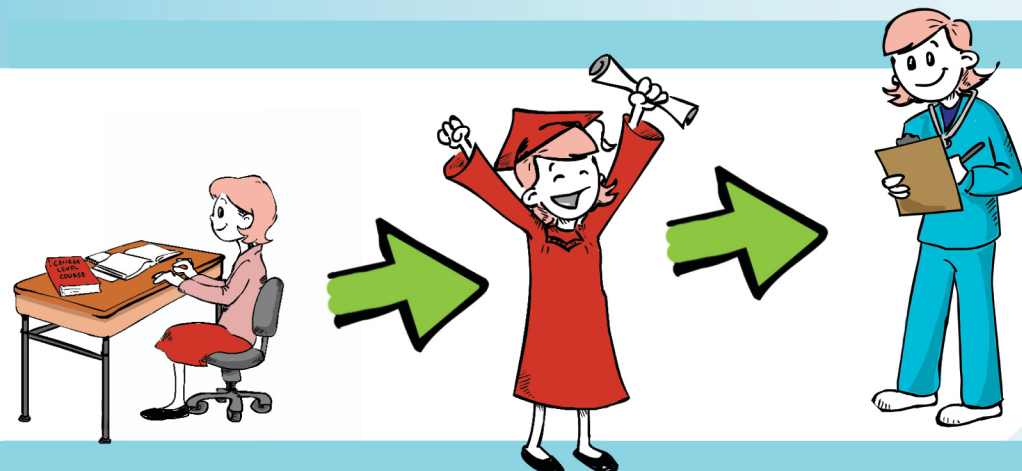
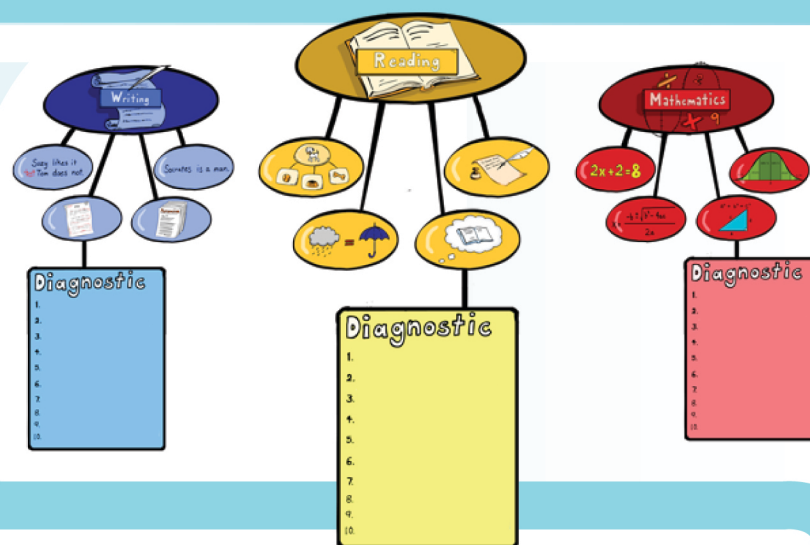
HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE?

It can take 3 to 5 hours.

It's a placement test AND a diagnostic test.

The **placement test** determines which of your skills are college-ready, developmental, or adult basic education level.

The **diagnostic tests** then do a deeper evaluation of your skills.



WHY IS THE TSI IMPORTANT?

The TSI is based on the Texas College and Career Readiness Standards. In other words, you will need to know this to succeed in your college courses and career!
